Main Line squads made their presence felt Friday and Saturday at the 84th Stotesbury Cup on the Schuylkill River.

In girls' action, **Conestoga** sophomores Rory McCue and Ali Siegele placed third in their semifinal for the Girls' Junior Double event on Friday, but were 12 seconds away from placing in the top two for a spot in the finals. The Girls' Lightweight Double placed fourth in their semifinal.

On Saturday morning, the Girls' Freshman Quad, with Jenny Alcorn, Mary Kate Lyons, Lara Dorfman and Maddie Amsterdam, placed third in their final race. In the Girls' Junior Quad, Nicole DeStefano, Maggie Dwyer, Augusta Harris and Sabrina Luthra placed first in their final race, 4 seconds ahead of the second-place boat.

The Conestoga Girls' Senior Doubles raced in the finals and placed sixth.
